The Danbury Institute, a conservative Christian advocacy group, [accused the museum of displaying "child pornography"](#) in a December 2024 open letter. Backed by [some local elected officials](#), they demanded the photographs be removed. "Children cannot consent to such photography, and displaying these images publicly only perpetuates their exploitation," the group said. "Such actions degrade the values of our community, endanger the innocence of childhood and contribute to a dangerous cultural shift."




DANBURY INSTITUTE AIDS IN PASSAGE OF BIPARTISAN TAKE IT DOWN ACT

On May 19, 2025, President Trump signed into law the TAKE IT DOWN Act — legislation that criminalizes the publication of non-consensual intimate imagery and provides victims of deepfake pornography with legal recourse in protecting themselves and their dignity online. The Danbury Institute team was glad to support this legislation, to help bring it across the finish line, and to witness the signing of the bill into law in the Rose Garden.




PASTORS, LEADERS ATTEND NATIONAL EVENT IN DALLAS







